- **Double Chance (Kèo 2 chiều):** This bet allows the bettor to cover two possible outcomes of the game. For example, a bet on

“home team or draw” means that the bettor wins if the home team wins or the match ends in a draw. This type of bet provides a higher chance of winning but typically offers lower odds.

- **Correct Score (Kèo tỷ số chính xác):** As the name suggests, this bet involves predicting the exact score of a match. Predicting the exact score is much more difficult, but it can offer substantial returns if the correct score is predicted.
- **Half-Time/Full-Time (Kèo hiệp 1/hiệp 2):** In this bet, you place a wager on the outcome at both half-time and full-time. For example, betting on “home team to win at half-time and full-time” means the home team must be leading at half-time and win the match at full-time for the bet to be successful.

3. Factors Affecting Serie A Betting Odds

Several factors influence the **tỷ lệ bóng đá** or Serie A betting odds, and understanding these factors can give Vietnamese bettors an edge when placing wagers. Some of these factors include:

- **Team Form and Performance:** A team’s current form is one of the most important factors when setting odds. Teams that are on a winning streak will generally have lower odds for victory, while teams in poor form will have higher odds.
